

Antiques: Then and Now

38 years ago, back in Germany I owned a bright orange Fiat 500, a tiny car the size like the modern Easter-egg-on-wheels cars of today.

Every other year the car had to be brought in to the "technical supervisory association" for a strict technical check-up to get the two-year registration sticker. This was a very authoritarian check up, whereby the cars were test-driven by a state employee. Usually after a car was six to eight years old, it would not be allowed to pass, because the salt, ice and snow had done lots of damage to the body by then. If an inspector didn't pass the car, there was little the owner could do; they were just plain out of luck and had to junk the car.

On my little Fiat the bottom of the door jams and the floor on the passenger side had rusted away and one had to position the feet real carefully towards the middle of the car. By looking down through the hole in the floor, one could see the street whiz by underneath. I think the car body was only holding together by the roof. The car had no chance, all the Bondo and fiberglass didn't help, it was ready for the junk heap!

I remember how one determined driver tried to get his 18 year old VW to pass inspection. He commented on how dry the air was in the office and tried to lubricate the deal by pushing a good bottle of schnapps across the counter towards the inspector.

Back then I had never heard of antique cars, and only the museum in Munich had a few cars of famous people on display. I think it's great that especially here in California old cars last so many years and can be driven on the streets too!


