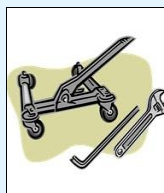

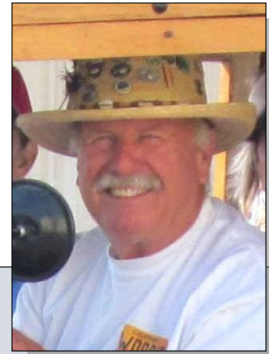

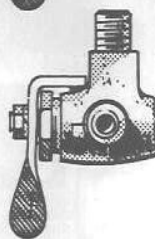
FUEL SHUT-OFF VALVES USED ON THE 1928-1931 MODEL "A" FORD



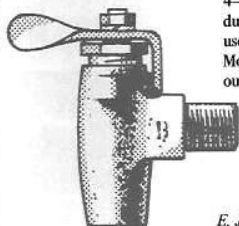
1- Shut-off valve with forged steel handle used October, 1927, to April, 1929. Location: Under tank inside car.



2- Forged handle changed to steel stamping in April, 1929. Shaft modified to accept thinner handle.



3- Housing changed in late 1929 to provide square shoulder for wrench. Packing nut changed from inner thread to outer thread.



4- Shut-off valve introduced in April, 1931, for use on indented firewall Model "A". Location: outer firewall under hood.

A meeting of MARC members and future members was held at home of Dale Kibben, with 12 persons in attendance. Dale was appointed chairman for this meeting. He read constitution and by-laws, and these were approved by group. Next point of business was naming of club, which after much discussion was decided on HARBOR AREA REGION MARC. After this new members submitted applications and dues were collected. An election of officers was held with following officers serving with end of fiscal year March 1st, 1958. Officers were elected as follows:

President - Dale Kibben
Secretary - Rodney Gott
Treasurer - Ron Harris

Dues were turned over to treasurer. Meeting was established as second (2nd) Tuesday of each month, meetings being held in members' homes for privacy. Ed Montgomery volunteered to have next meeting at his home. Dates September 10th.
Meeting was informal and social hour followed.



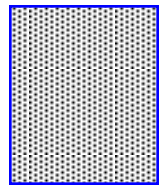
