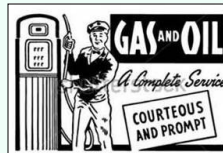

How about a ball cap to go with the shirt or vest? Jan has them, too.

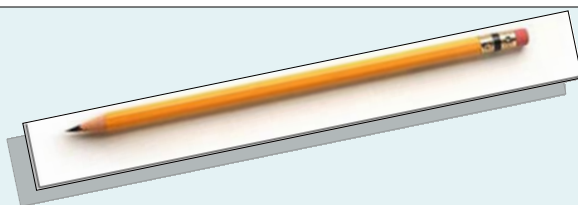
Merchandise Sale!

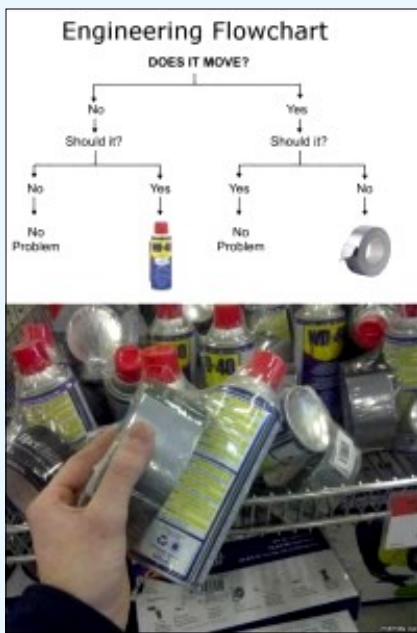

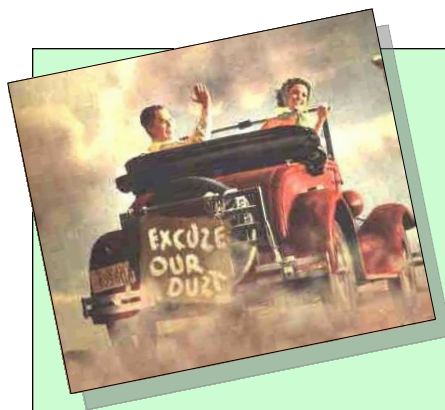

17 Harbor members went out into the Pacific to try and catch a glimpse of some whales (or whatever).

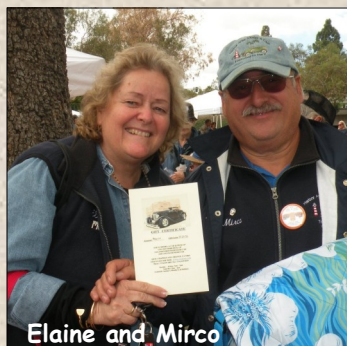
