- 1 C. lard
- 1 C. molasses
- 1 C. sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 T. vinegar
- ½ tsp. salt
- 1 scant C. water
- 2 heaping tsp. baking soda
- 1 T. ginger
- 1 T. cinnamon
- 4-5 C. flour



Combine and scoop spoonfuls on baking sheet. Bake 20 minutes. Serves 12.

Thick Sloppy Joes


- 3 pounds ground chuck

- 3 tablespoon dry mustard
- 3 cans tomato puree
- ½ Tabasco sauce
- 1½ cup ground carrots and celery
- 3 onions, chopped
- 1 large potato






